The summer flew by and we are back into a new school year. Maintenance, custodians and techs all worked extremely hard to get our schools up and running for the first day. Thank you for all your hard work.

Maintenance Projects

The following projects were done over the summer months:

- Relocation of Library, Fitness Room, Ab Ed Room, Bike shop at GFSS
- Roofing at Hutton, GFSS, and the Bus Garage in Midway
- Mansard at Greenwood
- PSECA Grant lighting upgrades at WBES and Hutton
- Nutrition Rooms - Greenwood and BCSS – Interiors to be completed over next few months.
- All gym floors in the District resurfaced
- Installed new drain pit on the east end of Perley parking lot
- Exterior of storage shed at Perley
- Shed at the back of GFSS -- installed washrooms
- Inspections of all school fire alarms, sprinkler systems and fire extinguishers
- Installed new water pump at Greenwood Elementary
- Analysis done on WBES heating system
- Installed Smart Boards and projectors



Technology Department

The Technology Department has been busy with the following:

- Configured and deployed secondary teacher laptops
- Added more network drops to accommodate wireless, video conferencing and some equipment moves.
- Upgraded BCSS server room to add air conditioning and replace/upgrade network switch
- Replaced all PC computers at BCSS with new Lenovo towers running Windows 7.
- Replaced most of PC computers at GFSS with same as above. Redeployed classroom towers to Room 208 lab. Room 207 lab and DLC have redeployed Seanix boxes. These are to be replaced once we have the VDI/RDS technology worked out.
- Refreshed image and checked hardware with elementary teacher laptops.
- Developed new image deployment methods for Windows PC's.



- Completed wireless deployment in all schools. Current access for staff only. Once stable, student access will be permitted. There will be a couple of additions to Perley and West Boundary schools. Bus garages and maintenance will still need to be done.
- Fibre installation for schools is complete.
- PLNet 'bottleneck' issue is tentatively repaired. Testing is continuing.
- Special Ed student netbooks configured.

Please note that these are major technology changes, and we will need to work through issues as they arise. Thank you to all staff for their patience.
